The key to any benefit from the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), is the discharge papers or DD 214. If you still have your original, please record it at your local courthouse and let your family know.

There are certain instances, where the VA needs to have information on your current dependents (spouse, children, etc.) and your past dependents, such as your ex-wife or husband. There may be a need for current marriage licenses, divorce decrees, birth certificates for veterans and divorce decrees for any past marriages of your spouse.
